SIMPLIFIED DIVORCE

THIS PACKET IS DESIGNED TO BE USED WHEN YOU AND YOUR SPOUSE:

- 1. HAVE NO CHILDREN TOGETHER AND THE WIFE IS NOT NOW PREGNANT;**
 - 2. HAVE WORKED OUT HOW YOU WILL DIVIDE THE THINGS YOU BOTH OWN (ASSETS) AND WHO WILL PAY WHAT PART OF THE MONEY YOU BOTH OWE (LIABILITIES);**
 - 3. ARE NOT SEEKING SUPPORT (ALIMONY) FROM THE OTHER PARTY;**
 - 4. DO NOT WISH TO HAVE MORE FINANCIAL INFORMATION FROM EACH OTHER THAN WHAT IS LISTED ON THE FINANCIAL AFFIDAVITS;**
 - 5. ARE BOTH WILLING TO GIVE UP YOUR RIGHTS TO A TRIAL AND APPEAL;**
 - 6. ARE BOTH WILLING TO GO TO THE CLERK'S OFFICE AT THE SAME TIME AND SIGN THE PETITION; AND**
 - 7. ARE BOTH WILLING TO GO TO THE FINAL HEARING AT THE SAME TIME.**

THIS PACKET SHOULD CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

1. INSTRUCTIONS
2. NOTICE OF LIMITATION OF SERVICES PROVIDED AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT
3. PETITION FOR SIMPLIFIED DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE (WITH INSTRUCTIONS)
4. CIVIL COVER SHEET
5. FINANCIAL AFFIDAVITS FOR BOTH PARTIES (WITH INSTRUCTIONS)
6. NOTICE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER (ONE FOR EACH PARTY)
7. MARITAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
8. AFFIDAVIT OF CORROBORATING WITNESS
9. FINAL DISPOSITION FORM
10. NOTICE OF RELATED CASES

After filling out all documents completely, make two copies of everything you filled out. One for you and one for the other party.

ALL ORIGINALS GO TO THE CLERK OF COURT.

You will also need to give the Clerk four (4) envelopes with stamps.

Read the instructions carefully and completely.
